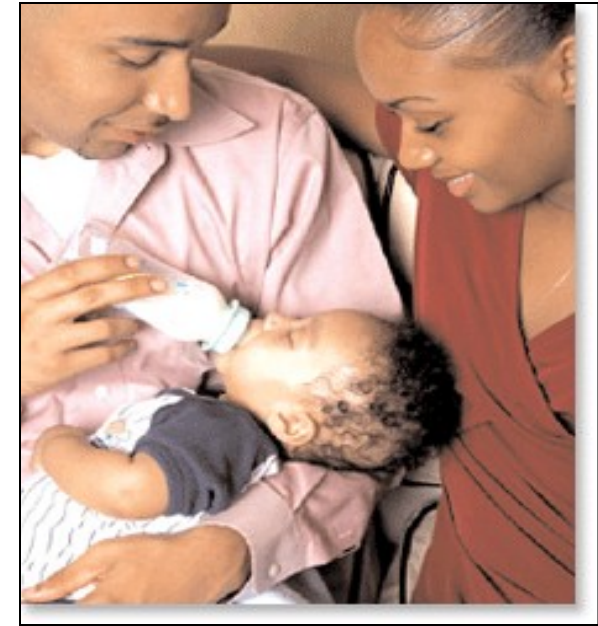

# Two Years Apart is Baby Smart



## FREE Family Planning services for 2 years!

(Medicaid Family  
Planning Waiver Program)

## SERVICES COVERED

If you are a woman of child-bearing age (14-55) who has lost full Medicaid coverage for any reason (*not just pregnancy coverage*), **you may be eligible for two years of Family Planning Services** including the following:

- ◆ Initial and annual family planning office visits
- ◆ Required lab tests and pap smear
- ◆ Family planning counseling visits
- ◆ Contraceptive supply visits
- ◆ Medicaid-covered, FDA-approved birth control methods including voluntary sterilization (tubal ligation)
- ◆ Screening for HIV
- ◆ Limited diagnosis and treatment for sexually transmitted infections and other gynecological problems including colposcopy



## WHERE TO RECEIVE CARE

During your pregnancy, *ask your prenatal care provider* if they will provide these services at their office.

If they do not offer these services after your six week post partum visit, contact one of the following for care:

If you received an application in the mail from Medicaid, complete it and mail it to Ms. Johnson at the above address. Note that you must apply for each year of coverage. Before your baby's first birthday, you must complete the application for the second year of coverage.
